



Congratulations on your new hotpots!

If you have a maintenance agreement with us, we will handle the watering of your containers. If not, you should check your new hotpots two or three times a week for water depending on the environmental locations. Hotpots that are located in hot, sunny, or windy locations will need watering more frequently than those located in shaded or protected areas. You can use a moisture meter available from any garden or hardware center and simply follow the enclosed instructions for usage. You can also use your index finger by inserting it into soil up to your second knuckle. If the soil is dry, you need to water until you can see the seepage under your pot.
